Habitat for Humanity of Greater Plymouth Announces 3 Homes to be built in Plymouth for Qualified Families/ Individuals

Plymouth— July 1 2018 — Habitat for Humanity of Greater Plymouth (<http://hfhplymouth.org>), which has delivered quality housing in partnership with families in need for the past 21 years, will be offering 1 single family home and 2 homes for veterans located at 865 Long Pond Road, Plymouth, MA. The homes to be constructed will have 3 bedrooms & 1¾ baths, approx. 1,300 sq. ft. including a full basement, yard, propane furnace, private well, private septic, kitchen, dining area, living room, vinyl tile kitchen & bath floors with carpeting in other rooms.

Applicants for single Habitat Affordable Home must live or work in one of the following towns: Plymouth, Kingston, Carver, Plympton, Lakeville or Middleboro and have maximum annual income limits of no more than 60% of the area's median income. Veterans applying for the 2 homes are encouraged to apply regardless of where they reside as long as they meet the Commonwealth of Massachusetts guidelines for veteran status and are willing to commit to helping build their own home, if physically able.

The Buyer will be required to pay closing costs of \$3,000. 2018 Maximum Household Income Limits as determined by HUD are \$45,300 (1 person), \$51,780 (2 person), \$58,260 (3 person), \$64,680 (4 person), \$69,900 (5 person) and \$75,060 (6 person). The application deadline is 4 PM on Month/day/year. To learn more about the application process a public information session will be held on Wednesday's, date, at 7pm and Saturday's, date, at 10am at the Plymouth Public Library, 132 South Street in Plymouth at 10am. Applications are available at the Habitat Office & ReStore in Carver, online at hfhplymouth.org, and the Public Libraries in Plymouth, Kingston, and Carver.

Dear Neighbors, Churches, Veterans Organizations, and Veterans Agents:

We need your help! In all of our communities we face an affordable housing crisis as many of our neighbors continue to reside in unhealthy and unsafe living environments. This is even true for military veterans who have served our country and are now returning to start their civilian lives, hoping to own a home and raise a family. Habitat for Humanity of Greater Plymouth is honored to be leading a Town and community partnership in Plymouth to build three affordable homes, **two of which are for Veterans and their families**. The third home will be a traditional Habitat home.

Habitat for Humanity of Greater Plymouth provides selected families a new opportunity to build a better life. Despite our best efforts in all of our building projects to date, we have only received (on average) 20-25 applications from families that either work or live in one of our affiliated towns—Plymouth, Kingston, Carver, Plympton, Middleborough, and Lakeville. Of these applications, only a handful actually meet the income guidelines required to be a Habitat for Humanity homeowner. For Veterans there is no requirement to live or work in one of our towns. **Veterans are encouraged to apply regardless of where they reside as long as they meet the Commonwealth of Massachusetts guidelines for veteran status** and are willing to commit to helping build their own home, if physically able.

This is where we need your help. We invite you to help make a difference in a family's life by spreading the word of the start of our next Family Selection Process. Habitat for Humanity of Greater Plymouth will be hosting Informational Sessions in connection with the building three homes that will be located on Long Pond Road, Plymouth. In order to be considered as a candidate for one of these homes and to receive an application interested families are strongly encouraged to attend one of the Informational Sessions to be held in Plymouth in December 2018. Please see the attached flyer for details of these upcoming sessions and please share the information with anyone that you believe may have an interest and meet the qualifications for a Habitat affordable home. Time Period:

Application deadline shall be at least 60 days from the announcement of availability of applications. Marketing for these homes is scheduled so that purchasers are selected in time to participate, alongside volunteers, in the building of their homes.

- (11) Notices distributed via electronic communication through the Affordable Housing Trust.
- (12) At least one public information session to be held in Kingston to inform and assist potential applicants.
